Judy Ledgerwood blends modern music and abstract painting in her works to create inspiring constellations: like beads on a string, circles are arranged one beside the other or bundled, rectangles are slanted into rhombuses and placed one on top of the other like a column. On the one hand, the images adhere to strict horizontal and vertical structures, on the other, they pulsate to the rhythm of the painterly gesture: opulent color is opposed to light so as to define a new pictorial space.
